

Rhode Island 2017 Outdoor Shoot Schedule

In order to accommodate more shooters, we are changing our registration time. The new time for registration will be 8:30 to 9:30.

Again this season, in addition to our standard Field and Hunter rounds, the RIFAA is offering an Intermediate 50 yard maximum class with the intention of encouraging those that have not tried Field Archery to get involved. The Intermediate 50 yard class is open to anyone wishing to compete in this shortened, but still challenging class. The intermediate shooters will run concurrently with the standard distance shooters. Any group can be a mix of standard and intermediate shooters.

- Intermediate Round:
 - All targets are shot from standard distances except the 55, 60, 65 and 80 walkup.
 - The 55 is shot from 40 yards
 - The 60 is shot from 45 yards
 - The 65 and 80 are both shot from 50 yards.

If you have not tried shooting a NFAA outdoor round, feel free to reach out to Steve Morra or Ken Moore as we, along with others, will be more than happy to introduce you into the sport. At any of our tournaments we would gladly take someone new to teach them how to shoot the tournaments.

Youth and Cub	\$4, & \$3 respectively

If there are 2, 3 or 4 shooters in a style

First Place	\$5
Youth and Cub	\$4
